2015 Assessment Plumbing Project

The approved assessment at last year's meeting was to fund the replacement of the water lines and installation of new water meters—one for each unit. This was necessary because the water bill continued to be extremely high and the city utility manager and previous directors and employees said there was a leak. Isolating and repairing a leak would have been extremely difficult and costly. And if there was a failure in one unit,

turning the water off to that one unit was not possible. Since the completion of the project, water bills have been reduced by approximately \$200-\$400.
